ORDER

Shri Venkatesh Nayak has filed an appeal under section 19 of RTI Act, 2005 vide letter dated 30.01.2020 mentioning that the requisite information sought vide RTI application No. DOA&C/R/2019/51609/1 dated 01.11.2019 has not been provided by the Central Public Information Officer and transferred the RTI to NAFED under Section 11(1) of RTI Act 2005 as a third party vide letter dated 11.11.2019. However NAFED vide letter dated 02.12.2019 apprised that it is not covered under the RTI Act.



**Subject: Procurement of apples in Jammu and Kashmir during crop season 2019 by exempting the provisions contained in the extant guidelines of Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) and extend available Government Guarantee under Price Support Scheme (PSS) for this operation to Central Procuring Agency i.e. NAFED, for working capital as a one-time measure.**

Sir,


I am directed to refer to Ministry of Home Affairs' D.O letter no. F/No.11014/05/2014-K-I/III dated 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2019, Ministry of Home Affairs Note dated 05/09/2019, D.O. letter No.PS/CS/146/2019-I dated 4.9.2019 of Chief Secretary, Jammu & Kashmir and letter no. PS/Secy/Horti/2019/1706 dated 04.09.2019 of Horticulture Department, Government of Jammu & Kashmir and letter No. HO/MIS/Apple-J&K/2019-20 dated 05.09.2019 of NAFED, on the above cited subject.

2. I am also directed to convey the approval of this Department for undertaking procurement of Apples in Jammu and Kashmir during season 2019 as per the following details:-

- (i) To procure Delicious, American and Maharaji varieties of A, B and C grades of apples immediately till 15.12.2019 in Jammu & Kashmir, offered by the apple growers in the designated centers at Market Intervention Price (MIP), by Central Agency i.e. NAFED through designated State agencies namely Directorate of Planning and Marketing, Department of Horticulture, supported by the Director of Horticulture and Jammu & Kashmir Horticulture Processing and Marketing Corporation (JKHPMC).
- (ii) The State shall constitute a Designated Price Committee, as proposed by the State Government in their letter dated 04.09.2019. The constitution of Designated Price Committee, will include one member from National Horticulture Board (NHB). State Government will approve MIP recommended by the Designated Price Committee. Different MIP of apples is to be fixed by the Designated Price Committee based on the different variety/ grades of apples for payment to the growers.
- (iii) The State will make all effective mechanisms for procurement of particular variety and grade of apples through the constitution of a Quality/ Grading Control Committee.
- (iv) NAFED will make effective mechanisms to ensure that the payment is made to the State Agencies of the stock received as per the Designated Quality/ Grading Standard laid down by the Committee.




- (v) The MIP will be fixed by the Designated Price Committee and it should not exceed 5% of previous year's market prices of the same variety and grade of apples available from reliable sources.
- (vi) The procurement will be made strictly from genuine apple growers at MIP fixed by Designated Price Committee. To ensure the same, the State should devise suitable mechanism.
- (vii) The State may open procurement centers in all apple growing districts in the State of Jammu & Kashmir in addition to the proposed designated mandis in Sopore, Shopian and Srinagar.
- (viii) The reimbursement of losses to the Central Agency in undertaking procurement of apples will be shared equally between the Central Government and Government of Jammu & Kashmir.
- (ix) Government of Jammu & Kashmir shall ensure that the payment through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) to the apple growers is made directly into their Bank accounts within three days from the date of procurement of their produce.
- (x) The service charges of 3.5% shall be paid to Central Agency i.e. NAFED on the Market Intervention Price (MIP) value of the total quantity of apples procured, which will be shared between Central Procuring Agency i.e. NAFED and designated State Procuring Agency, as mutually agreed upon.
- (xi) NAFED may utilize available Government Guarantee of Rs. 39,000 crore provided for PSS operations to the extent of Rs. 2,500/- crore, as working capital for procurement of apples from the farmers in Jammu & Kashmir during crop season 2019, on submission of proof of procurement and transportation receipt of procured apples, as required by Lender Banks/Institutions.
- (xii) The reimbursement of central share of 50% of loss to Central Agency i.e. NAFED will be on submission of Audited Profit & Loss Accounts to this Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare within three months from the date of disposal and final vetting by Office of the Chief Adviser Cost, Department of Expenditure. The profit, if any, made in undertaking the operation will be deposited by NAFED into the Government account. The balance, State's share of 50% of loss will be reimbursed by Government of Jammu & Kashmir.
- (xiii) The State Government shall exempt all levy/ state duties for the procurement of apples during crop season 2019.
- (xiv) The State Government shall ensure the provision of basic amenities in the designated mandis and conduct wide publicity and awareness for procurement of apples in the state.
- (xv) NAFED shall make arrangements for transportation of procured Apples and ensure disposal of procured apple preferably on "First In First Out" basis within three months from the date of procurement in a transparent manner at competitive prices. In order to avoid recycling, the stock shall not be sold in the same market from where it has been procured during the procurement operation.
- (xvi) NAFED shall ensure release of timely payment to State agencies after receipt of proper documents as proof of procurement of appropriate variety/grade of apple from genuine farmers, payment of all the incidental expenses pertaining to procurement and disposal. Separate dedicated Bank Account must be



- maintained for this operation. Proper documents of purchase, sale, transportation and other procurement and disposal expenses shall be ensured.
- (xvii) NAFED shall submit daily operation report in an appropriate format to Ministry of Home Affairs and Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare.
- (xviii) The constituted Monitoring Committee under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretariat will monitor the operational issues of procurement of apple in Jammu & Kashmir. Any policy issues will be sorted out in consultation with the Ministry of Home Affairs and other related Ministries/Department of Central and State Government.
- (xix) The State will constitute an Implementation and Coordination Committee under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Government of Jammu and Kashmir and members from relevant Govt. Department and Agencies for continuous monitoring and coordination for smooth procurement of apple in the State.
3. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
